

## Partnership Agreement

### Agreement 585934-EPP-1-2017-1-FR-EPPKA2-CBHE-JP Improving engineers' skills in South East Asia

The present Partnership Agreement, hereinafter referred to as "the Agreement", is made and entered into by and between,

hereinafter referred to as the "coordinator", represented for the purposes of signature of the Agreement by Philippe Augé, President, the legal representative as defined in the Grant Agreement 585934-EPP-1-2017-1-FR-EPPKA2-CBHE-JP (2018-0027/001-001),

and the beneficiary:

Ubon Ratchathani University  
85 Sathonlamark Road, Warin Chamrap, 34190, Thailand

hereinafter referred to as the "beneficiary", represented for the purposes of signature of this Agreement by their legal representative, according to the Mandate previously signed and attached to the Grant Agreement (here in Annex I).

The parties hereby have agreed as follows:

#### Article 1 Subject of the Partnership Agreement

1.1 This Agreement defines the terms that govern the relations between the parties, by establishing their rights and obligations, and lays down the rules of procedure for the work to be carried out in order to successfully implement the Erasmus+ CBHE action 585934-EPP-1-2017-1-FR-EPPKA2-CBHE-JP (2018-0027/001-001) "GECKO" (hereinafter referred to as the "project").

1.2 The coordinator and the beneficiary, undertake to do everything in their power to carry out the work program forming the subject of this Agreement, which falls within the framework of the Grant Agreement n° 585934-EPP-1-2017-1-FR-EPPKA2-CBHE-JP (2018-0027/001-001), concluded between the coordinator and the Education, Audiovisual and Culture Executive Agency (hereinafter referred to as the "Executive Agency"), related to the above-mentioned project.

1.3 The subject matter of this Agreement and the related work program are detailed in the annexes of the Grant Agreement. The respective Grant Agreement terms and conditions, related annexes and guidelines, shall form an integral part of the present Agreement, and take precedence over it.

1.4 The coordinator and the beneficiary shall be bound by the terms and conditions of this Agreement, the Grant Agreement and any further amendments of the latter.

#### Article 2 Duration

2.1 This Agreement shall enter into force on the date the last party signs, but shall have retroactive effect from the starting date of the eligibility period laid down in the Grant Agreement: 15.10.2017. It will last for three years with an end date 14.10.2020 but it can be extended if necessary and per request from the coordinator.
