Additionally, we request that copies of their academic records and other required documents reach us by no later than August 31, 2023.

As part of our student scholarship project, AMCHAM organizes two annual programs. The first program is an orientation camp for new intake students that provides them with insight into the program and our community service requirements. The other is a career camp for students in their final year, which includes seminars, workshops, networking events, and business visits in Bangkok. During this program, graduating AMCHAM Scholarship Students have the opportunity to meet with the AMCHAM Board of Governors and other members, visit members' companies, and participate in job interviews to prepare students to enter the business world. All new intake and graduating students are expected to participate these camps. If these events cannot take place due to Covid-19, alternative programs will be offered online with key business experts and leaders.
