

Ubon Ratchathani University Announcement: Undergraduate Admissions to Ubon Ratchathani University for International Students, Academic Year 2024

Ubon Ratchathani University invites international students to apply for the 2024 academic year. The details are as follows:

1. Admission Requirements

1.1 Applicants must not hold Thai citizenship or Thai permanent resident status and must have completed/be completing high school grade 12 or the equivalent from an International Baccalaureate (IB) Program or the educational system of a specified country. The Council of University Presidents of Thailand's announcement on Criteria for Equivalent Educational Qualifications, announced on August 25, 2022, will be followed regarding approval of academic qualifications.

1.2 Applicants must be able to use the Thai or English languages or achieve a satisfactory score in standardized Thai or English proficiency tests such as TOEFL, TOEIC, IELTS, TU-GET, or CU-TEP. The faculty committee/board and university shall consider applicants entering English language programs without a satisfactory score on a standardized English proficiency test at their discretion.

1.3 Applicants must meet other program requirements.

1.4 Applicants may apply to only one program per admission round at Ubon Ratchathani University.

3. Admission Methods

3.1 In-person by submitting the application form with required documents at the Office of International Relations, UBU.

3.2 Email via intercoop@ubu.ac.th

Applicants must pay an application fee of 200 baht to the account number specified on the application invoice. Please send the bank deposit receipt or a copy of the transaction record to intercoop@ubu.ac.th as the final required step after transferring the money.

4. Application Documents

- 4.1 An application form (downloaded from Ubon Ratchathani University's website: http://www.english.ubu.ac.th)
 - 4.2 A copy of the applicant's passport with signature
 - 4.3 One 35 x 45 mm, full-face photograph taken within the last six months
- 4.4 A copy of the graduate certificate/diploma for grade 12 in English or its foreign equivalent with the applicant's signature (if not in English, an English translation is required)
 - 4.5 A copy of the official high school transcript in English
 - 4.6 One original health certificate in English issued within the prior month
- 4.7 A copy of a certificate of standardized Thai or English language proficiency test issued within the last two years
 - 4.8 A recommendation letter from a previous school or teacher
 - 4.9 A bank deposit receipt or a copy of the transaction record for the application fee

Applicants who miss one of the required documents in No. 4 may present the document(s) on the day of the application assessment interview. An applicant later found to be unqualified or to have provided fraudulent information is subject to university dismissal according to the university's regulations and may be subject to legal prosecution.

5. Consideration for selection

- 5.1 Applicants are responsible for verifying the details of their application, such as a faculty, a program, a study plan, etc., as well as the required documents listed in No. 3 before applying.
- 5.2 The university will review the entry requirement and announce the list of eligible candidates for the examination at a later date. The application fee is non-refundable under all circumstances.
- 5.3 Applicants who have paid the application fee and wish to change their program of study must submit a new application and required documents and pay the application fee within the specified date and time.

5.4 The respective faculties will consider the application subject to specific qualifications, and their decision is final.

7. Confirmation of intent to enroll and tuition payment

Successful applicants must confirm their intention to study and pay tuition fees within the specified date. Those who fail to pay the tuition fee will have forfeited their admission.

8. Student Enrollment

Successful applicants must enroll in a studentship within the specified date. Those who do not will forfeit their admission unless the applicant has received the university president's official permission for late enrollment. One must submit late enrollment requests within ten days from the specified enrollment date.
