



**Ubon Ratchathani University Announcement:  
Graduate Admissions to Ubon Ratchathani University for International Students,  
Academic Year 2024**

The university invites international students to submit applications for the 2024 academic year as per Sections 18 and 21, Ubon Ratchathani University Act 1990 A.D. (2533 B.E.) together with clause 8 of the Ubon Ratchathani University Regulations on Postgraduate Education 2021 A.D. (B.E. 2564). The details are as follows:

**Clause 1** This announcement is called "Ubon Ratchathani University Announcement on Graduate Admissions to Ubon Ratchathani University for International Students, Academic Year 2024".

**Clause 2** This announcement shall be effective from October 1, 2023 onwards.

**Clause 3** In this announcement:

"University" means Ubon Ratchathani University.

"President" means the President of Ubon Ratchathani University.

"Applicant" means a person who has graduated with at least a bachelor's degree or is currently studying in the last semester of a bachelor's or master's degree

**Clause 4** Admission Requirements

4.1 Master's degree

4.1.1 Applicants must not hold Thai citizenship or Thai permanent resident status and must have received a bachelor's degree or its equivalent or a graduate diploma from a higher education institution

4.1.2 Applicants must meet other specific entry requirements as set forth by the respective faculty and program. In terms of admission requirements and English language proficiency testing, applicants must meet the criteria as set forth by the respective faculty and program as specified in Article 4 of UBU's Announcement concerning English Proficiency Standards for Graduate Students, 2020.

4.2 Doctoral degree

4.2.1 Applicants must not hold Thai citizenship or Thai permanent resident status. They must have received a master's degree or its equivalent, an advanced graduate diploma from a higher education institution, or other qualifications specified by the UBU announcement.

4.2.2 Applicants must receive a certificate of completion from a standard English language proficiency test as per graduate program standards or those of the Commission on Higher Education. This certificate must have been issued within the last 2 years from the date of the announcement of results from Ubon Ratchathani University or language testing institutes until the date of student registration by using one of the following criteria:

(1) UBU-TEST	(100 points)	minimum score: 30 marks
(2) TOEFL (Paper-based)	(667 points)	minimum score: 425 points
(3) TOEFL (Computer-based)	(300 points)	minimum score: 120 points
(4) TOEFL (Internet-based)	(120 points)	minimum score: 40 points
(5) IELTS (Academic Module)	(9 points)	minimum score: 3.5 points
(6) TU-GET (Computer-based)	(120 points)	minimum score: 40 points
(7) CU-TEP	(120 points)	minimum score: 35 points
(8) TOEIC	(990 points)	minimum score: 400 points

4.2.3 Applicants must meet other specific entry requirements as set forth by the faculty and program.

Applicants who do not have a certificate for a standard English proficiency test specified in 4.2.2) may apply to a program, take the English Preparation for Graduate Studies course, pass the exam, or submit a test result within the second semester of Academic Year 2024.

Applicants who fail to meet the requirement in 4) shall have their student status terminated at the end of the first academic year of study.

If applicants apply to Ubon Ratchathani University, pass the required exams, and register for enrollment but cannot graduate from their previous institution of study on the date of new UBU student registration, their application to the university will be terminated.

6.1 In-person by submitting the application form with required documents at the Office of International Relations, UBU.

6.2 Email via [intercoop@ubu.ac.th](mailto:intercoop@ubu.ac.th)

Applicants must pay an application fee of 500 baht to the account number specified on the application invoice. Please send the bank deposit receipt or a copy of the transaction record to [intercoop@ubu.ac.th](mailto:intercoop@ubu.ac.th) as the final required step after transferring the money.

Applicants who are applying to any doctoral degree programs and do not have a certificate for a standardized English proficiency test may apply to a program but must submit the certificate on the date of new UBU student registration at the latest.

If applicants are monks or novices, they must show a letter from their superior religious official or the abbot allowing them to apply and further their studies.

Applicants who miss one of the required documents in No. 4 may present the document(s) on the day of the application assessment interview. An applicant later found to be unqualified or to have provided fraudulent information is subject to university dismissal according to the university's regulations and may be subject to legal prosecution.

### Clause 8 Consideration for Selection

8.1 Applicants are responsible for verifying the details of their application, such as a faculty, a program, a study plan, etc., as well as the required documents listed in No. 4 before applying.

8.2 The university will review entry requirements and announce the list of eligible candidates for the examination at a later date. The application fee is non-refundable under all circumstances.

8.3 Applicants who have paid the application fee and wish to change their program of study must submit a new application and required documents and pay the application fee by the specified date and time.

8.4 The respective faculty will consider the application subject to specific qualifications and their decision is final.

#### Clause 10 Confirmation of Intent to Enroll and Deposit Payment

Successful applicants must confirm their intention to study and pay tuition fees by the specified date. Those who fail to pay the tuition fee will have forfeited their admission.

#### Clause 11 Student Enrollment

Successful applicants must enroll in a studentship within the specified date. Those who do not will forfeit their admission unless the applicant has received the university president's official permission for late enrollment. One must submit late enrollment requests within ten days from the specified enrollment date.
