



**Udon Ratchathani University Announcement:
Graduate Admissions to Udon Ratchathani University for International Students,
Academic Year 2025**

Udon Ratchathani University invites international students to submit applications for the 2025 academic year. The details are as follows:

1. Admission Requirements

1.1 Master's degree

1) Applicants must not hold Thai citizenship or Thai permanent resident status and must have received a bachelor's degree or its equivalent, or a graduate diploma from a higher education institution

2) Applicants must meet other specific entry requirements as set forth by the respective faculty and program. In terms of admission requirements and English language proficiency testing, applicants must meet the criteria as set forth by the respective faculty and program as specified in Article 4) of UBU's Announcement concerning English Proficiency Standards for Graduate Students, 2018.

1.2 Doctoral degree

1) Applicants must not hold Thai citizenship or Thai permanent resident status and must have received a bachelor's degree or its equivalent, a master's degree or its equivalent, or an advanced graduate diploma from a higher education institution or other qualifications specified by UBU announcement.

2) Applicants must meet other specific entry requirements as set forth by the respective faculty and program. In terms of admission requirements and English language proficiency testing, applicants must receive a certificate of completion from a standard English language proficiency test as per graduate program standards or those of the Commission on Higher Education. This certificate must have been issued within the last 2 years from the date of the announcement of results from Udon Ratchathani University or language testing institutes until the date of student registration by using one of the following criteria:

(1) UBU-TEST	(100 points)	minimum score: 30 marks
(2) TOEFL (Paper-based)	(667 points)	minimum score: 425 points
(3) TOEFL (Computer-based)	(300 points)	minimum score: 120 points
(4) TOEFL (Internet-based)	(120 points)	minimum score: 40 points
(5) IELTS (Academic Module)	(9 points)	minimum score: 3.5 points
(6) TU-GET (Computer-based)	(120 points)	minimum score: 40 points
(7) CU-TEP	(120 points)	minimum score: 35 points
(8) TOEIC	(990 points)	minimum score: 400 points

3) Applicants who do not have a certificate for a standard English proficiency test specified in 2) may apply to the programs, take the English Preparation for Graduate Studies course, pass the exam or submit a test result within the second semester of Academic Year 2025.

Applicants who fail to meet the requirement in 3) shall have their student status terminated at the end of the first academic year of study.

If applicants apply to Udon Ratchathani University, pass the required exams and register for enrollment but are unable to graduate from their previous institution of study on the date of new UBU student registration, their application to the university will be terminated.

If applicants are monks or novices, they must show a letter from the superior religious official or the abbot allowing them to apply and further their studies.

3. Admission Methods

3.1 In-person by submitting the application form with required documents at the Office of International Relations, UBU.

3.2 Email via interadmission@ubu.ac.th

Applicants must pay an application fee of 500 baht, according to the account number specified on the application invoice. After the money has been transferred, please send the bank deposit receipt or a copy of the transaction record to interadmission@ubu.ac.th as the final required payment step.

Applicants who are later found out to be unqualified and/or whose information is found to be fraudulent will be faced with university dismissal, according to the university's regulations and may be prosecuted to the full extent of the law.

5. Consideration for Selection

5.1 Applicants are responsible for verifying the details of their application such as the faculty, program, study plan, etc. as well as the required documents listed in No. 4 before submitting an application.

5.2 The university will review entry requirements and announce the list of eligible candidates for the examination at a later date. The application fee is non-refundable under all circumstances.

5.3 Applicants who have paid the application fee and wish to change their program of study must submit a new application and required documents and pay the application fee within the specified date and time.

5.4 The respective faculty will consider the application subject to specific qualifications and their decision is final.

7. Confirmation of Intent to Enroll and Deposit Payment

Successful applicants must confirm their intention to study and pay tuition fees within the specified date. Those who fail to pay the fees will be considered to have canceled their application.

8. Student Enrollment

Successful applicants must enroll in a studentship within the specified date. Those who fail to enroll in the studentship will be considered to have canceled the application process unless the applicants have received the university president's official permission for late enrollment. The request for late enrollment must be submitted within 10 days from the specified date of enrollment.
