



## Ubon Ratchathani University Announcement Application for International Students, Undergraduate, 2025 Academic Year

Ubon Ratchathani University invites international students to submit applications for the 2025 academic year. The details are as follows:

### 1. Admission Requirements

1.1 Applicants must not hold Thai citizenship or Thai permanent resident status and must have completed/be completing high school grade 12 or the equivalent from an International Baccalaureate (IB) Program or the educational system of a specified country.

1.2 Applicants must be able to use Thai or English or achieve a satisfactory score in standardized Thai/English proficiency tests such as TOEFL, TOEIC, IELTS, TU-GET, or CU-TEP, equivalent to at least a CEFR A2 level.

Applicants applying for an English-taught program without a satisfactory score in a standardized English proficiency test must take the UBU Test organized by the Office of International Relations or take English training courses, pass the test specified by the training program, and acquire the necessary English knowledge and skills as required by the respective program of study. The training arrangements as well as contents are managed by the university.

Applicants applying for a Thai, or Thai and English, taught program without a satisfactory score in a standardized Thai proficiency test must take Thai training courses, pass the test specified by the training program, and acquire the necessary Thai knowledge and skills as required by the respective program of study. The training arrangements as well as contents are managed by the university.

1.3 Applicants must meet other specific requirements by the respective faculties and programs and consideration of applicants' qualifications will be under the discretion of faculties/programs.

### 4. Application Documents

4.1 Application form

4.2 A copy of applicant's passport

4.3 One full-face photograph of 450x350 pixels taken within the last six months

4.4 Copies of high school diploma/certificate (the original document with an official English translation)

4.5 Copies of official transcript (the original document with an official English translation)

4.6 A copy of certificate of standardized Thai and/or English language proficiency test (if any). This certificate must have been issued within the last 2 years.

4.7 A letter of recommendation from previous high school/institution (optional).

4.8 Health certificate issued by a certified doctor (one original and one copy)

4.9 Application fee of 200 THB (exclude transaction fee)

Applicants who are later found out to be unqualified and/or whose information is found to be fraudulent will be faced with university dismissal, according to the university's regulations and may be prosecuted to the full extent of the law.

### 5. Consideration for Selection

5.1 Applicants are responsible for verifying the details of their application such as the faculty, program, study plan, etc. as well as the required documents listed in No. 4 before submitting an application.

5.2 The university will review entry requirements and announce the list of eligible candidates for the examination at a later date. The application fee is non-refundable under all circumstances.

5.3 Applicants who have paid the application fee and wish to change their program of study must submit a new application and required documents and pay the application fee within the specified date and time.

5.4 The respective faculty will consider the application subject to specific qualifications and their decision is final.

#### **7. Confirmation of Intent to Enroll and Deposit Payment**

Successful applicants must confirm their intention to study and pay tuition fees within the specified date. Those who fail to pay the fees will be considered to have canceled their application.

#### **8. Student Enrollment**

Successful applicants must enroll in a studentship within the specified date. Those who fail to enroll in the studentship will be considered to have canceled the application process unless the applicants have received the university president's official permission for late enrollment. The request for late enrollment must be submitted within 10 days from the specified date of enrollment.
